

## **Meal Charge Policy**

**Urban Academy** participates in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) under the National School Lunch Program (NSLP). As a CEP school, all enrolled students are eligible to receive **one free breakfast and one free lunch each school day** regardless of household income.

#### 1. Free Meal Benefits

- All students enrolled at Urban Academy will receive one complete breakfast and one complete lunch per day at no charge.
- No meal applications are required for free meals under CEP.

## 2. Meal Charges for Additional Items

While the first complete meal is free, students who wish to purchase additional items will be responsible for the cost. The following guidelines apply:

- **Second Meals**: If a student requests a second breakfast or lunch, the full price of the meal will be charged.
- A La Carte Items: Extra items such as snacks, drinks, or individual entrée purchases are not included in CEP meal benefits and must be paid for at the time of purchase.

#### 3. Payment & Account Management

- Students may pay for extra items with cash or funds available in their meal account.
- Parents/guardians are encouraged to prepay for extra purchases using Linq Connect to avoid negative balances.

### 4. Meal Charge Limits & Notifications

- Students will not be allowed to charge second meals or a la carte items without sufficient funds.
- If a student's account has insufficient funds for an extra purchase, they will be informed at the time of service and given an alternative if available.
- Parents/guardians will receive **low balance notifications** via email, text, or letter if their child's meal account is running low.
